## TRACK II SESSIONS

•**“A Road Map to Succession Planning”** This session will provide an overview and definition of succession planning. It will identify the types and elements of succession planning and the key steps to the planning process. *Presenter: Catrese Brown*

•**“Responsibilities of Nonprofit Directors”** This session will clarify a director's fiduciary duties of “care, loyalty and obedience,” help avoid conflicts of interests, and show how to encourage organizational and financial transparency. *Presenter Mark Dick with Co-Presenter, Marjorie Engle*
